The Master of Arts in English, English Education Specialization provides students with preparation for and enhanced knowledge of teaching English in secondary schools. Framed with a commitment to equity, the program is designed for students who are:

- Seeking initial licensure; or
- Currently employed, full- or part-time, as an English language arts teacher in a Colorado public school; and
- Looking to revitalize their work with students and their own knowledge;
- Deepening their understanding of contemporary literacy scholarship and broadening their background to explore new new directions in the profession; and
- Deeply considering their practice and considering how they can do better and be better.
