The Department of Occupational Therapy is ranked among the top 10 programs in the nation by *U.S. News and World Report* and *Best Value Programs*, known nationally and internationally for its excellence. The department offers graduate-level education to prepare students as leaders in the field of occupational therapy. Faculty are engaged in nationally and internationally recognized research and community outreach that meet the needs of people facing challenges in everyday life.

In 2022 we transitioned from a Master's-level degree to a three year Doctorate in Occupational Therapy.
